Las Vegas Airspace Management

Guest speaker, William P. Wadley, Operations Manager of Las Vegas TRACON, will provide a thorough overview of the complex Las Vegas airspace environment, to include Class B Structure. Mr Wadley will discuss safety issues for general aviation aircraft as well as commercial and business aircraft. Departure and arrival routes for IFR traffic as well as Class B routings will be presented, along with the recent changes that have taken place. in the past year.

Presentation will include 3D analysis of airspace traffic and the hazards associated with different runway configurations at Las Vegas McCarran Airport. Outlying airports will also be discussed, particularly how local traffic fits in with the voluminous air carrier operations in our complex environment. In addition, Joseph Kuhlen, our newest FFAST Team member and Southwest Airlines pilot will present a brief and informative overview on "Owner Authorized Maintenance of Aircraft." This "doubleheader" is a "must see" for all aviators in the local area.
