Flying the Grand Canyon Special Flight Rules Area, Best Glide Speed and Distance

Toni Mattei, Grand Canyon tour pilot veteran, will discuss how to fly around the Grand Canyon SFRA airspace. Toni is a 14CFRPart 135 tour operator captain with 20 years experience operating in and around the Grand Canyon SFAR. She has also worked as a CFI where she checked out and familiarized many students with operating safely around the SFRA.

The Grand Canyon discussion will include familiarization with the airspace, rules and regulations for operating in the area, safety concerns and traffic flow, proper communication and flight planning a safe and fun trip to one of the seven wonders of the world.

Following the Grand Canyon familiarization, we will cover the Topic of the Month, "Best Glide Speed and Distance," and how critical they are for safely operating your aircraft.
