One important component of our ongoing efforts to improve surface safety at RAL Airport involves conducting a Runway Safety Action Team (RSAT) meeting at least once each year. In conjunction with airport management, we will be conducting a local RSAT meeting on Tuesday July 12, 2016. The meeting is scheduled from 10:30 a.m. to 01:30 p.m. in the Riverside Airport Terminal, 6951 Flight Road, Suite 203, Riverside, CA 92504
