

Pilot Deviations Prevention Response and Learning Culture

A pilot deviation simply means a pilot did something that didn't comply with an ATC instruction, clearance, or regulation. Most deviations are **unintentional** and occur during normal operations — often to competent, experienced pilots.

Our goal is to understand **what deviations look like in real life, why they happen, and how we prevent them** through better planning, communication, and decision-making.

Today's session focuses on pilot deviations — not as a disciplinary topic, but as a **safety learning opportunity**.
