Continental, Lycoming, Rotax and radial engine manufacturer Kalisz have all cleared the Hjelmcö AVGAS 91/96 UL for use in many of their engines. We are honored to have Lars Hjelmer join us for a Town Hall seminar about the development of UN-Leaded Aviation fuel and to conduct a comprehensive question and answer session.
