

# Getting your next FAA Medical and using the new on-line MedXpress to do it.

It seems to be getting more difficult to get your FAA Medical. More and more medications and maladies are coming under the scrutiny of the FAA Medical Certification branch. Redding FAA Aviation Medical Examiner (AME) Dr. William Baker will talk about the process to get your next medical and answer questions you may have on medications and medical conditions. Dr. Baker will also discuss the now required use of the FAA on-line MedXpress service that pilots must use to apply for their next medical.
