

## Transitioning to LSA: Flying with a Driver's License as your Medical - What You Need to Know.

Many older pilots are deciding to transition to Light Sport Aircraft, which requires only a Driver's License to be used for medical certification. Light Sport Aircraft are a different breed of aircraft and require an understanding of their flying characteristics and specific transition training needed. Certified Flight Instructor and FAASafetyTeam Representative Irwin Fust will present a comprehensive look at what transitioning to LSA entails.
