

## Introduction to G-1000 glass panel and ADS-B

An introduction to the operation of the Garmin G-1000 glass panel used in many recent general aviation aircraft. An introduction to ADS-B, Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast, the aircraft tracking system which will eventually replace radar tracking. The presentation will run from 10 am to about 2 pm with a BBQ tri-tip lunch around noon.
