Directions: Directions to the Ground Campus are:

If arriving from north of the Redding Municipal Airport, take Airport Blvd south and turn right onto Knighton Road (opposite the entrance to the airport terminal).

If arriving from south of the Redding Municipal Airport, take Airport Blvd north and turn left onto Knighton Road (opposite the entrance to the airport terminal). After turning onto Knighton, make first right turn onto Lockheed Drive.

After you turn onto Lockheed Drive (it parallels Airport Road), you will continue northbound for about one-half mile. Turn left onto Devere Drive, which is just before the large, landscaped lawn area in front of the IASCO Flight Training Ground Campus building. There is an "IASCO" sign in one of the front windows of the building. After turning onto Devere Drive, make an immediate right turn - this will take you toward the parking lot. You can park in any available space. Please enter the building through the double glass doors at the front reception area, which is up the walkway, just past the flagpoles.
