

Preparing for a Practical (Check rides and Flight Reviews)

Designated Pilot Examiners and Flight Instructors frequently conduct inflight evaluations. Whether its a check ride for a new certificate or a flight review to keep flying privileges current, each require a measure of preparation on the part of the pilot. DPE Vince Nastro and CFI Mike Tritten share thoughts on how to arrive for your evaluation prepared and ready to demonstrate proficiency. The topic is applicable to all pilots from student to ATP.

Directions: From north or southbound CA-99, exit at "North Buhach Rd/Castle Airport". Proceed north 2.0 miles then turn right on E. Bellevue Rd. (Museum is to the left). Terminal will be through the airport entrance on right following Aerodrome Entry -> bear right onto Airflight Dr -> left onto Thunderbird Ave -> right on Turbine Dr -> left on Perimeter Ave. (It's easier than it sounds! Look for signs!)
