Led by South American bush pilot Laura LaBore, this event will include a discussion of aeronautical decision making (ADM) when life is on the line.

Laura spent the last 7 years as a missionary pilot in South America, flying into some of the most remote airstrips in the world to perform medical evacuation flights and to deliver supplies to some of the most isolated people in the world. In her years of flying, she has often been presented with tough choices in regards to when to fly and how to maintain safety in a difficult environment. In particular, she will focus on how to deal with distractions in the cockpit and during preflight planning. Her insight will be valuable to pilots of all skill levels.
