A Different Look at ADS-B From an FAA Insider

John Fisher has over 30 years of experience in the aviation industry. Prior to joining the Federal Aviation Administration, John's work involved upgrading surveillance systems of 40+ USAF platforms. Currently, John Manages FAA Surveillance policy such as TSO, and Advisory Circulars, related to ADS-B out/in, UAT, Mode S, and ATRBS systems.

Mr. Fisher Will Provide an overview of Surveillance and it's quick multi-generational leap to ADS-B. He will explain the benefits of the three "IN" applications, SURF, AIRB, and ATAS, discuss equipage considerations, and provide an outline of ADS-B airspace rules.
