40 years of Observations (ever seen a bird with low wings?)

William Hill, a 6,000 hour, ATP-CFI-AIM, AGI 2010 FAA Western Pacific Region FAASTeam representative of the year and 2014 FAA WP region Challenge Coin recipient and a 40 year holder of a pilot certificate will discuss his observations regarding the past 40 years (pilot behavior and accidents).

Directions: Driving from the south:

North 101 to Atherton Avenue exit in Novato, quick left onto Binford Road (there's a large sign listing all the airport businesses on the corner there) Follow Binford about 2 miles until you reach the airport, then take a right on Airport Road.

From the North:

South 101 to the Atherton avenue exit in Novato, take a left and cross over the highway (watch the crazy lane alignment- you want to go straight through on Atherton Avenue), the turn left onto Binford Road (look for the large billboard listing the airport businesses on the corner). Follow Binford Road about 2 miles until you reach the airport, then take a right on Airport Road.

The administration building midway down this road on the left, with the flag out front, and you get into the Scanlon hangar through the right-hand glass door of the admin building to which it's attached. There are a few parking places along the hangar row and maybe even some in the small lot right outside the admin building. Another lot just past that building and hangar with a man gate through the fence, and you should be able to get in through the man door in the big hangar door.

Flying In: Park anywhere on the main ramp.... then walk to the Administration building.... and follow instructions in the above paragraph.
