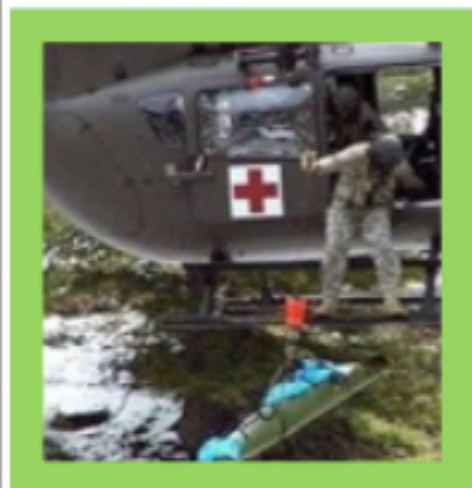
# Brian Brown

Sacramento, CA: It was Memorial Day 2012 when fire captain Brian Brown, his wife, and daughter gathered together to fly his private plane from Lodi, California to Idaho, to visit his eldest daughter. Brown, who became a certified pilot in 2002, prepared his four-seat, bright yellow Cessna Skyhawk that he affectionately called LIMA. But what was planned to be a wonderful family gathering turned into a nightmare when Brown encountered turbulent weather and the plane crashed into an isolated Idaho mountainside.



Brian Brown articulates in great detail the fateful events that led to his plane crash and the unforgettable 15 hours of danger, rescue efforts, and miracles that ultimately ensured their survival.

Brian's presentation will be interesting and inspirational for all, but a must for all pilots. Human error and aeronautical decision making is the least understood area of our aviation education. Brian does all pilots a great service by sharing his story.
