

Aircraft Accident Helicopter Aerial Rescue and Personal Survival Pre Planning

No one wants to think about an aviation accident ... especially pilots! However some forethought and pre- planning may save the lives of you and your passengers if something goes wrong and forces you down in mountainous / hostile terrain. CHP Helo Pilot Shawn Bainbridge will educate attendees on: What kind of personal survival kit everyone should carry? What are the best ways to get rescuers to find you? What initial first aid, and survival steps should you take? When an aviation asset does find you what should you expect from the helo? 1 hour lecture on rescue, survival, first aid, and signalling; and then a tour of the CHP Helo; and live demo of the helo rescue hoist, how to put on the rescue harness etc.
