The easiest thing is to enter the street address into your GPS on your phone or vehicle map device.... If you have neither then make your way to downtown Redding, proceed to the Jail (tall building) and find the street called Placer, then proceed west about 13 blocks. At the top of the hill you will pass the entrance to Benton airport (**DO NOT TURN THERE**), proceed to the next traffic signal (**Pleasant Street**) and then turn left, go one block and you will be looking at the EAA building. It will be on your left, park anywhere off the street (Also the EAA building is next to the Army National Guard unit/facility).
