IFR Round Table: VOR Approaches

Part of San Carlos Flight Center's IFR Round Table series, a discussion group of advanced and novice IFR pilots sharing knowledge about particular aspects of instrument flight. Held every 6-8 weeks, we focus on one small IFR procedure or topic area and spend a couple of hours talking through challenges, definitions, techniques, and safety issues in that topic area. This session is on VOR Approaches. We will look at the variety of instrument approach procedures (IAPs) that use VORs for guidance and talk about which ones are the most challenging. How many types of VOR Approaches can you think of? They are not all the same. The event begins with an initial introduction of the topic area by a flight instructor. Audience members are encouraged to participate. The event is for pilots to come together to share their knowledge and understanding. Audience members generally are IFR pilots of varying hours and capability, but IFR students are welcome as well. Note: This is a moderated discussion event.
