

## [FAASafety.gov](http://FAASafety.gov) Enhancements, Changes, Revisions,

### Corrections, “Bug” Fixes, Editorial Changes

#### **Changes of Interest to General Users**

1. Numerous enhancements and minor changes were made to the **AMT Awards Program** in the last launch. One additional enhancement was added in this launch. AMTs can now email a copy of their Core Course completion certificate to their employer, from a drop down box of registered Employers, or to any individual for whom they have an email address.
2. During the last update, we revised the email options for **user support** to include just one email address: [Support@FAASafety.gov](mailto:Support@FAASafety.gov) and included functionality allowing the user to choose from a drop down list of Subjects. We provided a text box for your question, comment, suggestion, or complaint, etc. We have **now included** a space for you to enter your telephone number in case we have questions or problems with your request.
3. The Password Recovery explanatory message was misleading and has been revised to be more clear.
4. A misspelled word in the AMT College Training certification statement was corrected.

#### **Changes of Interest to Representatives, FAASTeam Program Managers, and Regional FAASTeam Managers**

1. Here is **great news for Representatives!** We have upgraded the site so that users are no longer restricted to using just Internet Explorer (IE) when creating SPANS events, online courses, or accredited activities. You can now use Mozilla/Firefox (18% of our users), Netscape, Opera, Google Chrome (2% of our users), Apple Safari (8% of our users), and IE 8.0 (26% of our users; all IE versions comprise 72% of our users).
2. The **Text Boxes** used in creating SPANS events, Notices, accredited activities, and in a few other areas on FAASafety.gov, have been expanded to the full width of the work area, thus making more text visible without scrolling.
3. The **SPANS Event Report Builder** was inoperative for a few days and now works. In addition, the “Order By” feature was not working and now does.
4. An anomaly allowed Representatives to give **WINGS** credit to themselves. This has been corrected so that no one can give **WINGS** or **AMT** credit to themselves.
5. Another anomaly sent an email to 4,000 Airmen to approve a SPANS event. This has been corrected so approvals only go to FPMs or above in the permission list.
6. Due to FAA IT Security requirements, the number of **login attempts** to [FAASafety.gov](http://FAASafety.gov) for Representatives and above is now limited. After the limit is reached, the account will be locked; the Support Desk (or an Administrator) can unlock the account. If a password is forgotten, there is a password recovery feature.
7. The **Mailing List Management** module was updated.
8. The **WINGS** Credit selector in the “creating a syllabus system” has been corrected so that only one credit area can be selected.
