

## Enhancements to FAASafety.gov

Effective February 18, 2011

1. At the request of several FPMs, we modified the Give Credit page for a SPANS event to include a feature to enter the attendee's "Last Name, First Name" as another method to find a registered user. This is helpful if the attendee did not clearly print their email address on the attendance roster. The 1<sup>st</sup> screenshot is the default display. The 2<sup>nd</sup> screenshot shows the view if you choose to use the Name feature. We list the user's information, if it is available, so you can confirm it is correct before giving credit. Attendees not registered on FAASafety.gov must still be listed by email address. Warning – the Close Event feature (if that icon is available) must always be used before the Give Credit feature! In other words, you cannot "Give Credit" until the event is "Closed."

You may give credit to this seminar's attendees by selecting a user (Find by Name or Email) then pressing "Give Credit". 5. The WINGS Phase Summary Report is now Date capable. You can enter dates and get statistics for any range of dates. Note the explanatory text at the top for instructions and information.

## Aggregate User Statistics

The "From Date" and "To Date" that you enter are applied to the "Current" column only. This means that the number presented in the table below represents the number of WINGS phases that were earned within those dates, and are still current (not older than 12 calendar months) as of the "To" date.

The "Ever" column uses the data up until the "To Date" entered. The number shown in the table represents the number of Phases earned, current or not, from the beginning of the WINGS Program through that date.

In this example, 5,195 phases of WINGS at the Basic level were earned between 2/17/2010 and 2/17/2011, and were still current on 2/17/2011. The “Ever” column is the number of phases earned through 2/17/2011 since the WINGS program began. These numbers represent phases, not pilots, which is a challenge to solve in an upcoming change.

6. You will note on the Home page that there is now a scrolling list of names in the Industry Member's portal. The text in that portal has been modified to comply with FAA legal staff recommendations, while still giving additional exposure to our national Industry Members.

7. Authorized Instructors at a 14 CFR part 142 Training Center are now authorized to validate WINGS credits for pilots at their part 142 training center. If they do not have a current CFI certificate, they can check the appropriate box on the Give Credit page in the CFI Portal.

- AMT Employer reports for FPMs and RFMs have been modified so they are more useful. The Employer's Region/District is now displayed. In addition, a new search feature is available so we can find a particular employer without having to scroll through the entire list. Also, note that columns are now sortable by clicking on the column title. RFMs have Modify and Delete capability and FPMs have View capability. Here is an RFM screenshot; FPMs do not have the "Modify" or "Delete" icons shown at the right.
