## Check Out the Safety-Related Information Available to You

### Courses & Events

**Courses**—Complete safety courses on line. Hundreds of topics are available. You can register and complete any course at your convenience.

**Events**—Sign up for events in your area. You can register on line. Also, FAASafety.gov can send you notices any time a safety event close to you is scheduled.

### Pilots

- Register and participate in the **WINGS**—Pilot Proficiency Program. Earning your **WINGS** and maintaining any phase of **WINGS** will keep your flight review current.
- Awards programs for general aviation pilots.
- CFI Portal—Certified flight instructors have a special area to maintain proficiency and assist their students. Also, CFIs can create a special account for users who do not have a computer.

- Event & Activity Search—Pilots can search for seminars, training courses, flight activities, and more by topic or location.
- Team Member Rewards—A portal where pilots who complete a level of **WINGS** can receive special recognition and awards.

### Maintenance Hangar

- Seminars and Events—AMTs can search for seminars, training courses, and more by topic or location.
- IA Courses and Providers—An up-to-date data base that permits AMTs to search for FAA-approved certification courses and certification groups by location, topic, and training date.
- My AMT—Allows AMTs to enroll and complete accredited courses toward earning a Bronze, Silver, and Gold Certificate of training within the AMT Awards program. AMTs can also monitor their progress through My AMT.

- Other Award Programs—AMTs can search for information about general aviation awards programs.
- Special Projects—A portal that links AMTs to information that will help AMTs identify and manage risks to improve their safety performance.
- Toolbox—A list of flight safety-related Web sites for AMTs. Description and links are listed for each maintenance category and site.

**Resources**—Download safety information on a wide range of topics. Find Notices and a library of FAA guidance, regulations, handbooks, ADs/Service Bulletins, etc. Also you will find links to other sites so you can search hundreds of safety topics and find information to help improve your proficiency.
