Small UAS Training Courses for Remote Pilots Available Online

Drone pilots who have **Part 107 Remote Pilot Certification** can now reset their 24-month currency through online training courses. The training is required prior to conducting operations at night.

The training is free and available at [FAASafety.gov](https://www.faa.gov/faasafety).
There are three courses:



Part 107 Small UAS Recurrent

NEW This new recurrent course is for any Part 107 certificate holder and is required prior to operating at night.

Course Number: ALC-677



Part 107 Small UAS Recurrent - Part 61 Pilots

Part 107 remote pilots who are also certificated and current under Part 61 are eligible to take this course.

Course Number: ALC-515



Part 107 Small UAS Initial - Part 61 Pilots

This course is designed for certificated and current Part 61 pilots who do not yet hold a Remote Pilot certificate under Part 107.

Course Number: ALC-451

Individuals who do not hold a Remote Pilot certificate and want to fly under Part 107 must take the Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) Initial Aeronautical Knowledge Test at an FAA-approved Knowledge Testing Center. The test has a fee associated with it.

Part 107 remote pilots who have completed the updated test or training will be allowed to operate at night in accordance with the new rules.
