

DEEPWATER HORIZON INCIDENT FLIGHT OPERATIONS

Information for all pilots operating in or adjacent to the Deepwater Horizon Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR) Airspace

- Check all NOTAMS and Advisories because they change frequently
- Contact Omaha 99 for VFR Traffic Advisories within the TFR
- Maintain contact with Omaha 99 while operating within the TFR
- Know the rules of the road for operating within the TFR ***BEFORE operating in the TFR***
- Familiarize yourself with the Regional Airspace Management Plan available at https://1afnorth.region1.ang.af.mil/deepwater_spill/default.aspx
- Maintain situational awareness at all times – REMEMBER this is a VFR operation
- Be aware of aircraft entering/exiting the TFR when operating adjacent to the TFR
- Be aware that surface oil burning within the TFR may temporarily cause areas of limited visibility
- Be aware of aircraft maneuvering within the TFR (e.g, aircraft departing ships/oil platforms, aircraft spraying dispersant, etc.)
