FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS Testing WSMR GPS 11-05 April 10, 2011 – April 27, 2011 Truth Or Consequences, NM


GPS testing scheduled as follows may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 333228N/1062313W or the TCS VOR 70.63 degree radial at 47.4NM.
- B. Dates and times:

10 APR 11 - 26 APR 11 0200Z - 1200Z AND 1900Z - 2300Z 27 APR 11 0200Z - 1200Z

- C. Duration: Tests may be conducted continuously during the requested periods.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 490NMR centered at 333228N/1062313W or the TCS VOR 70.63 degree radial at 47.4NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with decrease in altitude to 435NMR at FL250, 350NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 335NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 250NMR at 50 FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
