LAS VEGAS TRACON LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 11-06

SUBJECT: LAS VFR Practice Instrument Approach Hours

CANCELLATION: November 17, 2013

Las Vegas Terminal Radar Approach Control (TRACON) provides approach control service and standard IFR separation to VFR aircraft practicing instrument approach procedures to the McCarran International Airport (LAS). The primary approach control frequencies for McCarran are 125.9 (west), 118.4 (south) and 119.4 (east).

Due to the volume of air traffic operations at McCarran International Airport, VFR practice approaches will generally be accommodated only during the hours of 1:00 AM (Local) until 6:00 AM (Local) daily. Pilots are encouraged to contact the TRACON Traffic Management Unit at (702) 262-5926, prior to departing for practice approach operations.
