


RUNWAY SAFETY ALERT

QUAD CITY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (MLI)

February 2011 Hot Spots

- HOT1** (Runway 23 closed) When holding short of Runway 23 on Taxiway B2, be aware of the very short taxiway and that the hold lines are very close to the ramp. On Taxiway A, you may be asked to hold short of the approach for Runway 23.
- HOT2** The intersection of three runways can be confusing. Be aware of hold short markings and signs, and remember to verify your compass heading with your assigned runway before making an intersection departure. Within the intersection, each runway is identified by runway location signs (black square – you're there).
- HOT3** On Taxiway K, the Runway 31 holding position is in an unusual location. Watch for holding position markings and signs as you approach.
- HOT4** The centerlines of Taxiways Foxtrot and Hotel diverge on a gradual curve when proceeding east to west on the north ramp. Watch for the surface painted markings where the centerlines of Foxtrot and Hotel diverge to ensure the proper route is followed.



Pilots Be Alert:


- ◆ Runway 9 and Runway 10 thresholds are parallel and in close proximity
- ◆ Runway 5-23 and future Runway 10-28 are temporarily CLOSED
- ◆ Check NOTAMs daily for movement area closures and approach procedure availability
- ◆ Always have a current airport diagram with you in the cockpit

and remember... *If in doubt... ASK!*


