GPS Testing
WSMR GPS 11-10
August 1, 2011 – August 20, 2011
Ruidoso, NM

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 331306N/1063005W or the BWS VOR 314.3 degree radial at 34NM.
- B. Dates and times: GPS testing is scheduled on August 1st through August 20th, 2011 from 0200-1200 UTC and 1900-2300 UTC daily.
- C. Duration: Each event may be intermittent during the requested periods.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 350NMR centered at 331306N/1063005W or the BWS VOR 314.3 degree radial at 34 NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with decrease in altitude to 300NMR at FL250, 225NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 225NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 175NMR at 50 FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
