**PORTLAND ATCT/TRACON LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 11-01**

**SUBJECT:** Temporary Airport Traffic Control Tower (ATCT) at Pearson Field (VUO) Located in Vancouver, Washington.

**CANCELLATION:** October 6, 2011

The FAA will be establishing a temporary Airport Traffic Control Tower (ATCT) at Pearson Field (VUO) in Vancouver, Washington. The temporary ATCT will be open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. and operational from April 1 through October 6, 2011.

Pilots arriving at VUO should contact VUO ATCT at least five miles from Pearson Field for entry into the Pearson Class D airspace. Pilots departing VUO should contact VUO ATCT prior to taxiing. Tower frequency will be 119.0. CTAF will change to 119.0. Unicom will remain 123.0.

Pilots should be aware of the close proximity of Pearson Field and Portland International Airport (PDX). Pilots should also be aware of increased PDX traffic on the final to PDX RWY 10L (overflying Pearson Field) during the months that the VUO ATCT is operational.
