**FLIGHT ADVISORY**  
**GPS Testing**  
**CSFTL GPS 11-06**  
**December 1, 2011 – December 12, 2011**  
**Jacksonville, FL**

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 302000N/0800000W or the CRG VOR 89.9 degree radial at 78.2NM.
- B. Dates and times:  
01-12 DEC 2011 2100-0245Z
- C. Duration: Each event may last up to 45 minutes followed by 15 minutes off. More than one event may occur during requested times.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 300NMR centered at 302000N/0800000W or the CRG VOR 89.9 degree radial at 78.2NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with decrease in altitude to 255NMR at FL250, 191NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 147NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 73NMR at 50 FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

**The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.**
