GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 352635N/1163856W or the DAG VOR 353.2 degree radial at 29NM.
- B. Dates and times:  
**16-17 OCT 11 0700Z-1200Z**
- C. Duration: Individual event duration will be 45 minutes followed by 15 minutes off time and may repeat within the allotted times.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 280NMR centered at 352635N/1163856W or the DAG VOR 353.2 degree radial at 29NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with decrease in altitude to 230NMR at FL250, 155NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 150NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 110NMR at 50 FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

**The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.**
