GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

A. Location: Centered at 325159N/1060806W or the BWS VOR 293.8 degree radial at 6.7NM.

B. Dates and times:

12-15 OCT 11	0200-1200z
18 OCT 11	0600-1200z
19-21 OCT 11	0400-1200z
22 OCT 11	0200-1200z

C. Duration: Each event may be intermittent during test.

D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 351NMR centered at 325159N/1060806W or the BWS VOR 293.8 degree radial at 6.7NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with decrease in altitude to 300NMR at FL250, 250NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 221NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 173NMR at 50 FT AGL.

E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
