
**FLIGHT ADVISORY**  
**GPS Interference Testing**  
**PACAF 12-04**  
**August 8 –August 16, 2012**  
**Richardson, Alaska**

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 642620N/1463425W or the BIG VOR 320 degree radial at 34NM.
- B. Dates and times:

08 August, 2012	1801-2000Z
09 August, 2012	0000-0200Z and 1801-2000Z
10 August, 2012	0000-0200Z
11 August, 2012	0000-0200Z
13 August, 2012	1801-2000Z
14 August, 2012	0000-0200Z and 1801-2000Z
15 August, 2012	0000-0200Z and 1801-2000Z
16 August, 2012	0000-0200Z
- C. Duration: A single event lasting between 90-120 min and may start at any time during the requested period.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 285NMR centered at 642620N/1463425W or the BIG VOR 320 degree radial at 34NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with a decrease in altitude to 236NMR at FL250, 160NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 136NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 77NMR at 50 FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

**The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.**
