SUBJECT: Clearance Delivery Service via Telephone within San Antonio ATCT Airspace

CANCELLATION: January 31, 2014

Within San Antonio ATC Tower airspace, direct radio communication is not always possible between pilots and controllers at all airports and landing areas, when aircraft are not airborne. In order to provide the most expeditious means of delivery of ATC clearances San Antonio Tower and TRACON have installed a dedicated, recorded telephone line. This phone line is monitored continuously, and may be used for Clearance Delivery purposes beginning immediately, as an alternate method of obtaining an ATC clearance or departure release when radio communication is not possible. The availability of this method of obtaining a clearance does not preclude pilots from obtaining clearances through San Angelo AFSS. Users must be aware that all communications on this line are recorded, even though there is no recording alert tone.
