


## GPS Testing WSMR GPS 12-04 June 15 - June 24, 2012 Alamogordo, NM

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 333547N/1063502W or the TCS VOR 061 degree radial at 40NM.
- B. Dates and times: 15-24 June, 2012 0200-1200Z
- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 371NMR centered at 333547N/1063502W or the TCS VOR 061 degree radial at 40 NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with decrease in altitude to 319NMR at FL250, 241NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 234NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 179NMR at 50 FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
