

A Couple of Quick Updates to FAASafety.gov

- We noticed some confusion with the new course catalog page, so we made a slight adjustment. The default has been changed so that the Courses in Progress page is always Open when a user first goes to that page. That way they can see immediately which courses they need to finish. See the example below. (Yes, we saw the Open / Close link was reversed. We'll fix that as soon as we can.)

In addition, you may re-take a course 90 days after the previous completion, and receive additional WINGS or AMT credit for that course. Most courses are free. However, if there is a cost, it will be shown by displaying the word "Cost" in the COST column

We also provided the ability to use the Airman ID, sometimes called the FTN. These two new search methods may help you find a user more quickly if you know the airman information. Note that you can use the present search methods or the new methods, but not both, for the same search. Note that there are two Find Users links, depending on which method you are using.
