

**Orlando Special Notice**  
**Advising VIP Visit and Expected Restrictions.**  
**October 29, 2012**

**FDC 2/1446 ZJX - 2/1447 ZMA** SPECIAL NOTICE... THERE WILL BE A VIP VISIT TO THE ORLANDO AREA ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2012 THAT WILL REQUIRE THE ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY FLIGHT RESTRICTION (TFR). THE AIRSPACE RESTRICTION WILL IMPACT GENERAL AVIATION OPERATIONS WITHIN AND AROUND THE ORLANDO AREA TO INCLUDE OPERATORS ATTENDING THE ANNUAL NBAA CONFERENCE. THIS EARLY NOTIFICATION IS INTENDED TO ALLOW OPERATORS TO PLAN ACCORDINGLY IN ORDER TO HELP MITIGATE THE POTENTIAL IMPACT.

PURSUANT TO 49 USC 40103(B), THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) CLASSIFIES THE AIRSPACE DEFINED IN ASSOCIATED NOTAM(S) AS "NATIONAL DEFENSE AIRSPACE". ANY PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY OR WILLFULLY VIOLATES THE RULES CONCERNING OPERATIONS IN THIS AIRSPACE MAY BE SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CRIMINAL PENALTIES UNDER 49 USC 46307. PILOTS WHO DO NOT ADHERE TO THE IMPLEMENTED AIRSPACE RESTRICTION MAY BE INTERCEPTED, DETAINED AND INTERVIEWED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OR THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE. PILOTS WHO DO NOT COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS, SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS OR PROCEDURES IN THE PUBLISHED NOTAM WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A) THE FAA MAY TAKE ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION, INCLUDING IMPOSING CIVIL PENALTIES AND THE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF AIRMEN CERTIFICATES; OR
- B) THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT MAY PURSUE CRIMINAL CHARGES, INCLUDING CHARGES UNDER TITLE 49 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 46307; OR
- C) THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT MAY USE DEADLY FORCE AGAINST THE AIRBORNE AIRCRAFT, IF IT IS DETERMINED THAT THE AIRCRAFT POSES AN IMMINENT SECURITY THREAT.

ALL AIRCRAFT OPERATORS SHOULD FREQUENTLY CHECK NOTAMS BEFORE AND DURING THIS EVENT FOR POSSIBLE CHANGES TO ENSURE THEY HAVE THE LATEST PROCEDURES.
