PUEBLO ATCT LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 13-01

SUBJECT: New Runway Construction Activities at the Pueblo Memorial Airport.

CANCELLATION: June 27, 2013

New runway construction activities are underway at Pueblo Memorial Airport. The new runway will be located 1000 ft. north of the current runway 8L/26R. During this time construction crews will be applying asphalt and various pieces of construction equipment will be in use.

The construction activities affect various aircraft operations and procedures to runways at Pueblo Memorial Airport. **Pilots must check NOTAMS** and listen carefully to the Automatic Traffic Information Service (ATIS) broadcast prior to arriving and or beginning of taxi for departure—**Expect changes on a daily basis.**

Due to these construction activities aircraft operating at Pueblo Memorial Airport are advised of the following changes to airport / air traffic operations:

- Various runway and taxiway configurations will be needed to complete the runway project. Different runways and taxiways will be closed at different times. **(See NOTAMS for specific details)**
- Lighted X's will be used to indicate closed runways. **(See NOTAMS for specific details)**
- Some approaches may not be available during the construction period. **(See NOTAMS for specific details)**
- Land and Hold Short operations on Runway 17 will be unavailable during periods of the construction. **(See NOTAMS for specific details)**

New Runway construction area depicted in red.

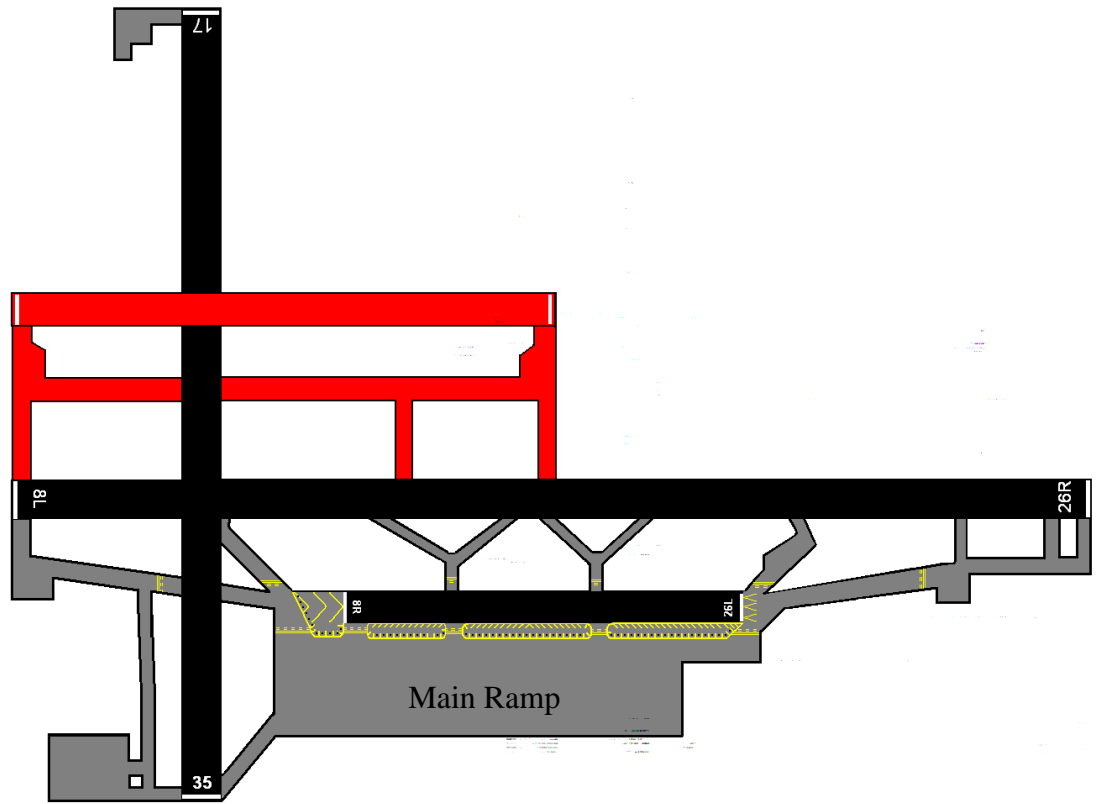
