Santa Rosa Airport Traffic Control Tower LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 13-01

SUBJECT: Charles M. Schulz - Sonoma County Airport (STS), Runway 01-19 Temporary closure and remarking.

CANCELLATION: December 17, 2015

As part of recently initiated construction activities at the STS, Runway 01-19 was closed to all air traffic starting on or about the week of September 30, 2013. The runway will be remarked to reflect changes in magnetic variation, and reopen as Runway 02-20. It is anticipated that Runway 02-20 will be reopened for air traffic December 18, 2013.

Upon reopening in December, the length of Runway 02-20 will be temporarily reduced to 4,600 feet. This temporary runway closure is part of a larger airport improvement program project that will enhance airport operational safety and extend the length of Runway 14-32 to 6,000 feet and Runway 02-20 to 5,202 feet. Additional construction activity including temporary closures of the Airport's Runway 14-32, temporary nighttime closures of the entire airport, and remarking of all taxiways will occur in the spring/summer/fall of 2014. Pilots are requested to check for active NOTAMs and remain alert for airfield changes.
