## **HONOLULU CONTROL FACILITY LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 12-07**

SUBJECT: Practice Instrument Approaches at Kalaeloa Airport

CANCELLATION: November 26, 2014

Pilots are advised that IFR separation will be provided by HCF Approach Control to VFR aircraft conducting practice approaches at Kalaeloa Airport. Except for heavy aircraft/B757, 500 feet vertical separation may be applied between VFR aircraft and between a VFR and an IFR aircraft. Pilot requests for practice instrument approaches should contact HCF Approach on 118.3/269.0.

Pilots not on an IFR flight plan should state, "Practice instrument approaches in VFR conditions," when requests are made to ATC. If a pilot wishes to proceed in accordance with instrument flight rules, he/she must specifically request and obtain an IFR clearance.

Due to the close proximity to Honolulu International Airport, practice approaches may be discontinued due to the volume of arriving and departing IFR aircraft at Honolulu. When the reported Kalaeloa Airport weather is VMC, pilots are expected to land or remain in the VFR pattern.

Multiple approaches or missed approach instructions will be predicated on traffic volume to Honolulu International Airport and prior approval by approach control.
