## **HONOLULU CONTROL FACILITY LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 12-09**

SUBJECT: Parachute Operations at Dillingham Airfield

CANCELLATION: November 26, 2014

Parachute operators conducting jumps in the Dillingham parachute jumping area are advised of the following procedures to comply with Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR) Part 105, Parachute Operations.

- a. Notify the Honolulu Control Facility (HCF) via fax (808) 840-6210 of parachute operations to be conducted. Information must be received no earlier than 24 hour before or no later than 1 hour before the parachute operation begins. Please include (FAR 105.15):
  - i. Date and time of the operation.
  - ii. Altitude at which the aircraft will be operated when parachutists exit the aircraft.
  - iii. Duration of the intended operation.
  - iv. Name, address and telephone number of the person requesting the authorization.
  - v. Registration number of the aircraft to be used.
- b. Prior to departing on each jump operation, call HCF APPROACH on 126.5 MHz for a transponder code.
- c. When airborne, Air Traffic Control will expect three transmissions from the pilot.
  - i. Five minutes to jump.
  - ii. Jumpers away.
  - iii. All Jumpers down.
