SUBJECT: MULTIPLE RUNWAY CROSSINGS

CANCELLATION: September 3, 2014

Springfield Air Traffic Control Tower, located at Abraham Lincoln Capital Airport, Springfield, Illinois, provides for the safe, orderly and expeditious flow of traffic.

In 2011, Springfield Tower was granted a waiver for multiple runway crossings at the center of the airport. The waiver allows ATC to issue multiple runway crossings at the following runway intersections:

- a. While taxiing/operating on Runway 04/22, crossing Runway 13/31 and Runway 18/36.
- b. While taxiing/operating on Runway 13/31, crossing Runway 04/22 and Runway 18/36.
- c. While taxiing/operating on Runway 18/36, crossing Runway 13/31 and Runway 04/22.
- d. While taxiing/operating on Taxiway B, crossing Runway 04/22 and Runway 18/36.

The following wording will be added to the Airfield/Facility Directory entry for Springfield Abraham Lincoln Capital Airport:

“Multiple runway crossings may be authorized by ATC at specific intersections.”
