

Runway 7R/25L Closure



Dear Tenants,

In an effort to improve your flying experience we will be performing repairs to Runway 7R/25L. The crack seal and slurry of runway 7R/25L will improve asphalt conditions by repairing cracks, weather sealing, reducing FOD, and eliminating vegetation.

In order to ensure a quality lasting repair, the runway will be unavailable for the duration of the improvements. The project is scheduled to last approximately two weeks starting Monday, April 21, 2014 at 2200L and will reopen for service on Monday, May 5, 2014 at 0700L.

Although this repair work will cause a disruption to operations we hope you are just as excited to see the completion of these much needed repairs. Throughout the project, we will strive to minimize the impact on taxiing traffic at runway crossings. We will keep two taxiways, Bravo, Delta, and/or Lima, open for runway crossings during each phase of work.

Due to the phasing structure during this construction project you are encouraged to check NOTAMs daily for available taxiways for runway 7R/25L crossings.
