FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS Interference Testing PACAF 14-03 18-20 August, 2014 Anchorage, Alaska

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

A. Location: Centered at 611451N1495041W or the ANC VOR 014 degree radial at 006NM.

Dates and times:

18-20 AUG 14 1530Z - 1745Z 2130Z - 2359Z

- B. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period
- C. NOTAM INFO: NAV (PACAF GPS 14-03) GPS (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE WITHIN A 244NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 611451N1495041W (ANC 014006) FL400-UNL DECREASING IN AREA WITH A DECREASE IN ALTITUDE DEFINED AS: 197NM RADIUS AT FL250, 132NM RADIUS AT 10000FT, 121NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL, 097NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.
- D. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
