SUBJECT: Fullerton (FUL) FAA Contract Tower (FCT) Closure for Maintenance


CANCELLATION: Jan 17, 2014

Effective Monday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014, at 9:00 P.M., Pacific Standard Time (PST), FUL FCT will be closed until further notice for scheduled maintenance activities. FUL FCT should return to service no later than (NLT) Friday, January 17, 2014, at 7:00 A.M., PST.

In conjunction with the FUL FCT closure, effective Monday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014, at 9:00 P.M., PST, FUL Class D airspace services will not be available. Please refer to the Airport/Facility Directory for class of airspace during FUL closure times.

The Fullerton Common Traffic Advisory Frequency is 119.1, which also controls airport lighting. VFR advisories are available through SoCal Approach on frequency 125.35. The ASOS for the Fullerton Airport is available at telephone number 714-870-1372. The most efficient way to obtain or cancel an IFR clearance is to call SoCal Approach at 800-448-3724. You can also contact Flight Service on frequency 122.2 or 122.4.

Planned maintenance activities may be completed ahead of schedule so please closely review published airport NOTAMS for FUL FCT service availability during this time period.
