GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

A. Location: Centered at 361307N/1150308W or the LAS VORTAC 019 degree radial at 10 NM.

B. Dates and times:

23 JAN 15	2230Z – 2359Z
24 - 28 JAN 15	0001Z – 0130Z and 2230Z – 2359Z
29 JAN 15	0001Z – 0130Z and 1700Z – 1830Z and 2230Z – 2359Z
30 - 31 JAN 15	0001Z – 0130Z and 2230Z – 2359Z
1 – 15 FEB 15	0001Z – 0130Z and 2230Z – 2359Z


C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.

D. NOTAM INFO: NAV (NAFC GPS 15-01 E2) GPS (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE WITHIN A 216NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 361307N1150308W (LAS 019010) FL400-UNL DECREASING IN AREA WITH A DECREASE IN ALTITUDE DEFINED AS:
174NM RADIUS AT FL250,
110NM RADIUS AT 10000FT,
107NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL,
104NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL

THE IMPACT AREA ALSO EXTENDS INTO THE MEXICAN FIR.

E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The time periods discussed in this advisory may be reduced or cancelled with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
