GPS INTERFERENCE TESTING  
CSG4 GPS 15-03  
31 July and 02 August, 2015  
Off coast of Myrtle Beach, SC (W-122)**

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 330000N/0780000W or the Wilmington VORTAC (ILM) 194 degree radial at 81NM.
- B. Dates and times:

31 JUL 15	0400Z – 1500Z
02 AUG 15	1400Z – 1900Z
- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV (CSG4 GPS 15-03) GPS (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE WITHIN A 350NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 330000N0780000W (ILM 194081) FL400-UNL DECREASING IN AREA WITH A DECREASE IN ALTITUDE DEFINED AS:  
299NM RADIUS AT FL250,  
233NM RADIUS AT 10000FT,  
194NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL,  
152NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL
- E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

**The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.**
