GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

A. Location: Centered at 401840N1133428W or the BVL VOR 147 degree radial at 26NM.

B. Dates and times:

27 – 28 APR 16	1500Z – 1730Z and 1830Z – 2200Z
2 – 5 MAY 16	1500Z – 1730Z and 1830Z – 2200Z
9 – 12 MAY 16	1500Z – 1730Z and 1830Z – 2100Z
16 MAY 16	1500Z – 1730Z and 1830Z – 2200Z
17 – 18 MAY 16	0300Z – 0700Z and 1500Z – 1730Z and 1830Z – 2200Z
19 MAY 16	0430Z – 0700Z and 1500Z – 1730Z and 1830Z – 2200Z
20 MAY 16	0430Z – 0700Z

C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.

D. NOTAM INFO: NAV (UTTR GPS 16-02) GPS (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE WITHIN A 474NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 401840N1133428W (BVL 147026) FL400-UNL DECREASING IN AREA WITH A DECREASE IN ALT DEFINED AS:

428NM RADIUS AT FL250  
349NM RADIUS AT 10000FT  
355NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL  
335NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL
