GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

A. Location: Centered at 634714N1455141W or the BIG VOR 172 degree radial at 14NM.

B. Dates and times:

9 – 12 AUG 16	0000Z – 0210Z	1630Z – 2000Z	2240Z – 0000Z
15 – 18 AUG 16	0000Z – 0210Z	1630Z – 2000Z	2240Z – 0000Z
19 AUG 16	0000Z – 0210Z	1630Z – 2000Z	

C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.

- 279NM RADIUS AT FL250
- 202NM RADIUS AT 10000FT
- 189NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL
- 116NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL

E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.
