The Federal Aviation Administration has openings for Aviation Safety Inspectors, FG-1825 job series. Aviation Safety Inspectors are responsible for the safety and certification of all aircraft and pilots.

General Requirements

US citizenship

Valid state driver's license

Not more than two separate incidents involving FAR violations in the last 5 years

Fluency in the English language

No chemical dependencies or drug abuse that could interfere with job performance

Must have worked in aviation in the last three years

For general aviation positions experience on aircraft at or under 12,500 lbs.

For air carrier positions experience on aircraft more than 12,500 lbs.

Operations Inspector Key Requirements

Valid unexpired CFII and Multi-Engine Instructor Rating

(not required for air carrier positions)

Possession of ATP or Commercial Pilot Certificate with instrument airplane rating

Possession of single and multi-engine land airplane ratings

Minimum of 1,500 total flight hours

Possession of a valid second – class medical certificate

Maintenance Inspector Key Requirements

Possession of an Airframe Certificate

Possession of a Powerplant Certificate

Avionics Inspector Key Requirements

Aircraft avionics experience involving the maintenance, repair, and troubleshooting of installed avionics systems on aircraft

OR

Aircraft avionics experience (which could include supervision or auditing) in a repair station; repair facility; military repair facility; or local, state, or federal governmental agency within the last 3 years
