FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS INTERFERENCE TESTING

PCMS GPS 17-23 (PINON CANYON MANEUVER SITE)

22-28 April, 2017 Pinon Canyon, CO

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

A. Location: Centered at 373013N1035915W or the PUB VOR 148 degree radial at 52NM.

B. Dates and times:

22 APR 17 1900Z - 2130Z 27 APR 17 1900Z - 2130Z 28 APR 17 2000Z - 2130Z

C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.

D. NOTAM INFO: NAV (PCMS GPS 17-23) GPS (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 366NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 373013N1035915W (PUB148052) FL400-UNL, 309NM RADIUS AT FL250, 223NM RADIUS AT 10000FT, 213NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL, 182NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.

E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
