FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS INTERFERENCE TESTING

YUMA PROVING GROUND (YPG) 17-02

6-28 January, 2017 Yuma, AZ

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 331328N1134850W or the BZA VOR 043 degree radial at 48NM.
- B. Dates and times:

06 – 15 JAN 17	2000Z - 2230Z
16 – 24 JAN 17	1900Z - 2230Z
26 – 28 JAN 17	1900Z - 2230Z

- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV (**YPG GPS 17-02**) GPS (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 329NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 331328N1134850W (BZA 043048) FL400-UNL DECREASING IN AREA WITH A DECREASE IN ALT DEFINED AS:

287NM RADIUS AT FL250

216NM RADIUS AT 10000FT

189NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL

168NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL

E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
